- Create and maintain family service files in accordance with programmatic guidelines; to include Health and Parent Involvement
- Facilitate monthly parent meetings
- Assist with reporting requirements

- Ability to use abstract reasoning, problem solving, planning, and analytical skills
- Ability to work well with young children and adults from various socio-economic and ethnic backgrounds, and provide guidance to foster their development
