Weatherization Assessor Job Posting

Reports to: Weatherization Director

Classification: Non - Exempt **Department/Site:** Weatherization

MAJOR FUNCTIONS:

Under direct supervision of the Weatherization Director, carries out various functions associated with weatherizing homes.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Develop and/or review the Work Order

- ➤ Create/Interpret work orders created in NEAT/MEHEA Program and provide input to Director and contractors about the scope of the job. Be familiar with tools and materials required for the job
- > Document information in DBA prior to and during weatherization process
- ➤ Identify and disperse required paperwork, (e.g. permits, releases, lead-based paint EPA requirements, historic preservation etc.)

Identify Contractors

- > Prepares work site and insures contractor are assigned appropriately
- Meet with contractors to discuss weatherization measures to be performed
- ➤ Assign and assist QCI with final inspections

Develop plan to execute work order on site

- Establish rapport and expectations with homeowner and contractor
- ➤ Conduct interior and exterior visual home inspection review with Director in order to confirm with the client the completion of any prerequisite work
- > Perform initial Job Site safety inspection
- ➤ Conduct interior and exterior visual home inspection to document pre-existing conditions
- > Identify any unsafe conditions and/or hazards and develop site-specific safety plan
- Conduct informative walk through with homeowner to explain what work will be completed and respond professionally to any questions or concerns. Obtain all required sign-offs from home owner before work begins. Identify homeowner issues (allergies, valuable items etc.)
- Take photo throughout the process

Prepare house for Contractors to execute work orders

Test in (e.g. Blower door, room to room pressure tests, IR scans, combustion, appliances etc.)

- Meet with contractors to discuss weatherization measures to be performed
- > Revise work order if necessary
- > Test out to ensure contractor has met all requirements of work order
- Performs other duties as assigned

Assist with Managing the project

- ➤ Evaluate job site and work-in-progress for compliance with OSHA, SWS, DOE, and OEO guidelines
- Ensure that contractors are completing work orders according to SC Field Guide and SWS
- Work collaboratively with contractor to ensure job efficiency (e.g. unforeseen circumstances)
- ➤ Work collaboratively with contractor to document work order changes with photos and notes

Job finalization Activities

- Walk through to verify that all components of the work scope have been completed
- > Assist QCI with final inspection

Final Documentation

- > Document outcome of work in DBA
- Ensures that work area is clean upon completion of assignment

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

- ➤ Considerable knowledge of construction procedures, building and related codes.
- ➤ Ability to understand and use energy evaluation equipment and material
- Ability to comprehend the technical language pertaining to weatherization (measurements, equipment readings etc.)
- ➤ Ability to communicate effectively with a diverse population of clients
- ➤ This position requires work in dark, uncomfortable and confined environments. Employee must be able to crawl through and work in constricted spaces
- ➤ Ability to follow oral and written directions

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

High School diploma or equivalent plus one year practical trades training, 3 years preferred. One year of construction/remodeling experience, or an equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities

PYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must be able to bend, stoop, stand, crawl, and walk on a regular basis. Must be able to lift/move at least 50lbs.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- ➤ Must have reliable transportation.
- ➤ Must attain completion of Site Built/Mobile Home Whole House Hot Climate Weatherization Training (SC Field Guide and Standard Work Specifications)
- ➤ Must attain completion of ASHRAE 62.2 Training
- ➤ Must attain completion of Lead Safe Training
- ➤ Must attain completion of OSHA 10 Hour Safety Training
- ➤ Must attain NEAT/MEHEA Software Training
